The landscape of professional ethics has changed significantly over the last ten years. This workshop will offer an opportunity to consider how these changes impact on our work.

Topics will include:

- Putting clients first - building a secure ethical base with clients as the foundation for therapeutic work
- Key implications for how we practise – particularly record keeping, safeguarding, working with social diversity, providing services online and with candour
- Maximising the potential for supervision to support ethical and effective practice.

This workshop will offer a mixture of input, short case studies, discussion and opportunities to ask questions.

Tim is the best selling writer in the UK about professional ethics for counselling and the talking therapies. Professor of the University of Bristol and Visiting Professor to the University of Malta. He is particularly interested in the ethical challenges encountered by practitioners and clients in their work together and finding the most ethical ways forward.
